Dear Parent/Carer

I very much look forward to welcoming all our young people back to school on Monday and, as promised earlier in the week, I have attached some useful information regarding our return. Within this you will find information about the school week, arrangements for Monday morning, an update on our Covid safe protocols and information about school uniform and P.E. kit. Can I take the opportunity to emphasise a couple of points within this covering letter and request that pupils arrive at school on Monday as follows:

- Pupils should arrive in full school uniform.
- Pupils should check Teams for their timetable and bring P.E. kit if required. If in doubt please bring P.E. kit anyway.
- Pupils should come equipped with a school bag, pen, pencil, books, jotters and any other necessary equipment.
- Pupils should try to arrive as close to 8.55am as possible and queue up outside one of the four main entrances until the bell rings.
- Pupils should bring with them their own face covering and put this on prior to entering the school building.

I would again urge that all pupils participate in the twice weekly rapid LFD testing programme, reporting their results to via the government web-site to help keep our school safe.


